ATTACHMENT A

The City of Palo Alto, Water-Gas-Wastewater Division, is a stucco beige building with a rust colored roof, next to two other identical buildings located at 3201 East Bayshore Road, Palo Alto, California. The building is identified by the letter "C." All three buildings are completely surrounded by a secure, barbed wire fence and guard post. Just in front of the barbed wire fence and north of the guard post is a wood sign that displays "City of Palo Alto, Municipal Service Center." The buildings run adjacent to Interstate 101. The main entrance to building C is located on the north side. The main entrance is notated with a sign overhead and green-colored door. Just to the left of the main entrance is another green colored door and windows. To the right of the main entrance is another green door and green roll-up door.

1. Records relating to a written qualification program and/or questionnaire for employees/contractors.

Records relating to pipeline operator qualifications to include but not limited to, identification of persons qualified to operate and/or work on the pipelines; identification of specific tasks that each employee who works on the water/gas pipelines is qualified to perform; dates of current qualification and verification of the same.
3. Written and oral examinations taken by each employee/contractor.
4. Employee/contractor work performance history and contact information.
