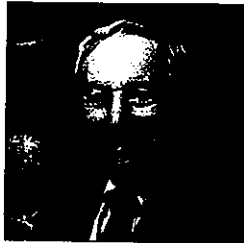


Can City Councilman Larry Klein be Trusted with City Funds?
