COMPLAINT RECEIVED

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission received the enclosed complaint, COM-08032020-01283, on 8/7/2020 4:26:00 PM. The information filed in the complaint is below and any attachments filed will be included.

The Complaint was submitted anonymously via the Enforcement Division's electronic complaint system.

The Complaint was formally filed against:

Gregory Lin Tanaka Greg Tanaka for Palo Alto City Council 2016

The Violations alleged are:

Statement of Intention to be a Candidate (85200)

Failure to file new Form 501 Statement of Intention to be a Candidate

A Candidate for local office must file FPPC Form 501, Candidate Statement of Intention, for each election, including reelection to the same office. The form must be filed before a candidate solicits, receives contributions and loans, or makes expenditures on behalf of their candidacy. Filing is the starting whistle allowing a candidate to begin these activities.

(CA Gov. Code Sec. 85200, 84215, FPPC Manual, Ch. 1.8)

Greg Lin Tanaka was elected to the Palo Alto City Council in November 2016. He has announced as an incumbent candidate for the same office in the November 3, 2020 election.

On New Years Eve 2019, there was a sudden influx of \$13,000 from five donors into Tanaka's 2016 City Council candidate campaign account that he had kept open. Mr. Tanaka reported these contributions on his July 1-Dec. 31, 2019 Form 460, which likely evaded notice by the public as it was in this off-election year. (Form 460 enclosed),

A \$1,259.80 balance is noted before the New Years Donations, showing only \$301 in expenses for the six-month term of the Report, and a mere \$322 in expenses for the previous six months in that Report. Given modest office expenses and a sufficient balance to cover them into the foreseeable future, it seems clear these sudden News Year's Eve contributions are the ramp-up funding for Mr. Tanaka's 2020 City Council campaign.

In January 2020, he raised \$12,550, including one donation for \$10,000. Tanaka's fundraising continued over the next six months with contributions flowing to his 2016 campaign committee totaling \$14,669. Added to the 2019 New Year's Eve contributions,

he could now boast of a \$26,350 fund in his old 2016 candidate account. (January 1-June 30, 2020 Form 260 enclosed)

Also seen on this Report, spending suddenly shot-up from approximately \$50 a month in 2019, to \$2,277 in just the first half of 2020. Included expenses reflect traditional campaign items such as voter data fees, Nation Builder campaign software, and canvassing costs.

As was stated above, filing is the starting whistle that allows Mr. Tanaka to solicit, receive contributions and make expenditures on behalf of his candidacy. Yet he delayed filing his required new Statement of Intention to be a Candidate 501 Form until July 14, 2020, six and a half months after receiving his initial 5 New Year's Eve 2019 contributions, totaling \$13,000, then going on to reap 11 more contributions through June 2020, totaling \$26,350.

Greg Lin Tanaka, incumbent candidate for Palo Alto City Council, has knowingly committed clear violations of law by both receiving illegal monetary contributions and making illegal expenditures from his 2016 campaign committee account months before filing a new 501 Form as legally required. (CA Gov. Code Sec. 85200, 84215, FPPC Manual, Ch.1.8)

Furthermore, this is not candidate Tanaka's first failure to comply with transparency rules regarding political campaign activities. Following his election in 2016, an FPPC investigation concluded that Councilmember Tanaka had committed three violations of Government Code Sections 84203 and 84211 – including failure to timely disclose large contributions and failure to properly disclose donor identities. Mr. Tanaka and his committee Greg Tanaka for City Council 2016 stipulated to the violations in September 2017.

In 2017 Mr. Tanaka offered the public a dual defense of his illegal behavior: 1) These were mere clerical errors and 2) I'm a rookie and didn't know any better (see enclosed Palo Alto Weekly article 9/1//17). Now, as an incumbent official whose recipient committee has been actively helmed by the same Treasurer for four years, those excuses don't fly.

Instead, the violations in this complaint demonstrate persistent attempts to shield the sources and amounts of his campaign contributions from public scrutiny by voters in his current election.

Knowing that Palo Alto voters often object to large campaign contributions in city council races, especially from developers, Mr. Tanaka and his campaign committee have consistently sought to sneak them in under the radar. In the 2016 election he did so by failing to timely report large contributions, collecting such contributions after the last preelection filing deadline and misrepresenting the source identities. In this 2020 election he is doing so again by collecting contributions early under the guise of his 2016 committee,

then failing to file his Statement of Intention to be a Candidate or to amend his Statement of Organization Form 410 in a timely manner.

Statement of Organization; Filing or Content (84101)

Statement of Organization; Amendment (84103)

Failure to file Form 410 amending the Statement of Organization for recipient committee within ten days of change.

Greg Lin Tanaka was elected to the Palo Alto City Council in 2016 and now is a candidate for a second term in this November's election. Government Code Sec. 84103 requires candidates/committees to file an amendment to the Statement of Organization within ten days of a change in information about the recipient committee (see also Instructions to FPPC Form 410). Furthermore, the name of a candidate's campaign committee must include the candidate's last name, office sought, and year of the election. (Government Code Secs. 84102 and 85201)

On July 15, 2020, Mr. Tanaka filed a Form 410 to amend his Statement of Organization, changing the name of his recipient committee to reflect the 2020 election year – from Greg Tanaka for Palo Alto City Council 2016 to Greg Tanaka for Palo Alto City Council 2020.

However, financial disclosures filed on behalf of his 2016 recipient committee, Greg Tanaka for Palo Alto City Council 2016, indicate that the purpose of that recipient committee changed as early as December 2019: from funding ongoing expenses and debt servicing while holding office to active fundraising and expenditures on behalf of his 2020 candidacy. Mr. Tanaka's July 15, 2020 Statement of Organization amendment was filed approximately seven months after activities of the recipient committee changed to active campaign support for the 2020 election year – well in excess of the ten-day filing requirement. Meanwhile, the 2016 recipient committee engaged in campaign fundraising and expenditures associated with Mr. Tanaka's 2020 candidacy throughout that period.

Contributions and Expenditures dating back to December 31, 2019 suggest change in recipient committee information.

On New Years Eve 2019, there was a sudden influx of \$13,000 from five campaign contributions to Mr. Tanaka's 2016 Campaign Committee (Greg Tanaka for Palo Alto City Council 2016). Mr. Tanaka reported this infusion on his January 23, 2019 Form 460 as required, but also with the consequence that the public likely would not take notice – it was a non-election year, the funds were reported by his 2016 campaign committee, and he had not yet indicated publicly or through Form 410 or Form 501 filings that he intended to run for re-election. From a 2020 voter's perspective the cash influx arrived sight unseen.

Additionally, as seen in the Greg Tanaka for Palo Alto City Council 2016 Form 460 filed on July 23, 2020, Tanaka's expenses suddenly shot up from approximately \$50

a month in 2019, to \$2,277 in the first half of 2020 with items such as voter data fee and canvassing costs listed.

Greg Tanaka for Palo Alto City Council 2016 reported a \$1,259.80 balance as of December 31, 2019 (Form 460, filed January 23, 2020) and only \$301 in expenses for the six-month term of the Report. There were \$322 in expenses in the six months prior to that (Form 460 filed July 30, 2019). Given such low expenses and a sufficient balance to cover them, the whopping News Year's Eve contributions certainly were not needed for regular, office-holder expenses or to pay off outstanding 2016 campaign debts.

The subsequent Form 460, filed on July 23, 2020, for Greg Tanaka for Palo Alto City Council 2016 again reported substantial new contributions far exceeding the previously demonstrated need to cover routine office holding and debt servicing expenses. Yet no Form 410 amending the Statement of Organization was filed until July 15, 2020.

In January 2020 alone, \$12,550 was raised as the donation pace accelerated during the year with more contributions to Tanaka's 2016 campaign committee. By June 30, 2020, Tanaka's 2016 Committee coffers brimmed with \$14,669 in new donations for the reporting period, as shown in the Form 460 filed on July 23, 2020. Combined with the prior New Year's Eve contributions, as of July 23, 2020 Mr. Tanaka could now boast of a \$26,350 war chest – all of which was collected (and accompanied new, 2020 campaign related expenses) in the approximately seven months prior to filing an amended Statement of Organization.

The one-month accumulation of over \$25,000, between December 31, 2019 and January 31, 2020, by Mr. Tanaka's 2016 campaign committee with no nexus to ongoing office-holding expenses, and including expenses such as the voter database that directly correllate to campaign activities clearly implies changes in recipient committee information. Pursuant to Government Code Section 84103, an amendment to the Statement of Organization should have been filed via Form 410 in January 2020 - well before the committee's July 15, 2020 Form 410 filing.

All local candidates, even if running for the same office, are required to file a new Form 410. Any solicitation, receiving or expending funds by Greg Tanaka for Palo Alto City Council 2016 associated with his 2020 candidacy are inappropriate until he files this form. Yet Councilman Tanaka and his 2016 recipient committee did not file a new Form 410 amending the Statement of Organization until July 15, 2020. He has violated the law.

Statement of Organization; Filing or Content (84101)

Statement of Organization; Contents (84102)

Name of recipient committee fails to reflect year of the election.

The name of a candidate's campaign committee must include the candidate's last name, office sought, and year of the election. (Government Code Sections 85201 and

84102). For approximately seven months, Mr. Tanaka solicited funds and made expenditures to support his 2020 candidacy without a valid Statement of Organization indicating the 2020 election year.

The Complainant, the Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission, and Respondent, both identified by name on the front of this document, hereby agree that this Stipulation, Decision and Order will be submitted for consideration by the Commission at its next regularly scheduled meeting.

The parties agree to enter into this Stipulation to resolve all factual and legal issues raised in this matter and to reach a final disposition without the necessity of holding an administrative hearing to determine the liability of Respondent.

Respondent understands and hereby knowingly and voluntarily waives any and all procedural rights under California Government Code sections 83115.5, 11500, et seq., and 2 California Code of Regulations sections 18361.4 through 18361.11, including but not limited to the issuance and receipt of an accusation, and the right to appear personally and be represented by counsel at his or her own expense in any administrative hearing held in this matter, to confront and cross examine all witnesses testifying at the hearing, to subpoena witnesses to testify at the hearing, and to have an impartial administrative law judge present at the hearing to act as a hearing officer.

It is further stipulated and agreed that Respondent has violated the Political Reform Act as described herein.

Respondent agrees to the issuance of the Decision and Order and imposition by the Commission of a penalty in the amount specified on the Stipulation, and a cashier's check or money order in said amount, payable to the "General Fund of the State of California," has been submitted by Respondent to be held by the State of California until the Commission issues its Decision and Order.

The parties agree that in the event the Commission refuses to accept this Stipulation, it shall become null and void, and within fifteen (15) business days after the Commission meeting at which this Stipulation is rejected, payments tendered shall be reimbursed to Respondent. Respondent further stipulates and agrees that in the event the Commission rejects the Stipulation and a full evidentiary hearing before the Commission becomes necessary, neither a member of the Commission, nor the Executive Director, shall be disqualified because of prior consideration of this Stipulation.

Candidate Intention Statement



CALIFORNIA 501

Who Files:

A candidate for state or local office must file this form for each election, including reelection to the same office. Exception: Candidates for county central committee that do not raise or spend \$2,000 or more in a calendar year are not required to file a Form 501.

When to File:

File the Form 501 before you solicit or receive any contributions or before you make expenditures from personal funds on behalf of your candidacy. This form is considered filed the date it is postmarked or hand delivered.

Ensure campaign deadlines are met. Go to www.fppc.ca.gov for most campaign disclosure filing schedules or check with your local filing officer.

Where to File:

State Candidates (including Judges):

Local Candidates:

Generally your county election office or city clerk. Electronic filing may be required.

Bank Account:

A separate campaign bank account must be established including for campaigns that are self-funded by the candidate. A bank account is not required if a candidate will not receive any contributions or make personal expenditures of less than \$2,000 in a calendar year. The filing and statement of qualification fees are not included in calculating the \$2,000.

How to Complete:

All candidates: Complete Parts 1 and 3. Candidates for elective state office: Complete Parts 1, 2, and 3.

Exception: Candidates for an election to the California Public Employees' Retirement Board, the State Teachers' Retirement Board, judges, and judicial candidates do not complete Part 2.

Part 1. Candidate Information

- Enter your name and street address.
- Enter the title of the office sought, agency name, and district number if any (e.g., City Council Member, City of Smalltown, Dist. 5).
- Enter your political party preference if seeking a partisan office. For a list of qualified political parties, go to: www.sos.ca.gov/elections/politicalparties/qualified-political-parties/.
- Check the appropriate box regarding the office's jurisdiction.

Part 2. Voluntary Expenditure Ceiling

This section applies to certain candidates for elective state office, including State Senate and Assembly and statewide offices.

The voluntary expenditure ceiling applicable to your office is set forth in FPPC Regulation 18545. You must state whether you accept or reject the expenditure ceiling. Candidates who accept the voluntary expenditure limit will be designated in either the state voter information guide (statewide candidates) or the county voter information guide (Senate and Assembly candidates) and may purchase space for a 250-word statement there.

You may amend the Form 501 to change your acceptance or rejection of the voluntary expenditure ceiling only under the following circumstances:

- Between the date of filing an initial Form 501 for an election and the deadline for filing nomination papers for that election, you may amend your statement of acceptance or rejection of the voluntary expenditure ceiling no more than two times as long as the limit has not been exceeded.
- If you reject the voluntary expenditure ceiling in the primary or special election but do not exceed the ceiling during that election, you may amend the Form 501 to accept the expenditure ceiling for the general or special runoff election and receive all of the benefits accompanying the acceptance of the expenditure ceiling. The amended Form 501 must be filed within 14 days following the primary or special election.

Personal Funds Notification:

You must disclose, if applicable, the date you contribute personal funds to your own campaign that exceed the expenditure ceiling. File an amended Form 501 within 24 hours by guaranteed overnight delivery, personal delivery, or, if applicable, by electronic means.

Part 3. Verification

The verification is signed under penalty of perjury. This form was prepared by the Fair Political Practices Commission (FPPC). For detailed information on campaign reporting requirements and the Information Practices Act of 1977, see the FPPC Campaign Disclosure Manual for your type of committee.
